1. Aleph — ■ — Primacy, source, bearing weight, covenant authority, unseen support.
2. Bet — ■ — House, inside space, ordered boundary, covenant dwelling.
3. Gimel — ■ — Movement, giving, lifting, pursuit, endurance.
4. Dalet — ■ — Doorway, threshold, passage, decision point.
5. He — ■ — Breath, window, revelation, opening of sight or sound.
6. Vav — ■ — Hook, nail, connector, joining together.
7. Zayin — ■ — Weapon, cutting edge, provision, memory, distinction.
8. Chet — ■ — Fence, enclosure, life preserved within boundaries.
9. Tet — ■ — Womb, coiled goodness, hidden potential.
10. Yod — ■ — Hand, action, spark, the smallest mark that begins work.
11. Kaf — ■ — Palm, capacity, vessel, containment, covering.
12. Lamed — ■ — Staff, goad, guiding rod, teaching and instruction.
13. Mem — ■ — Water, flow, chaos, and source of life.
14. Nun — ■ — Seed, sprout, continuance, lineage, endurance.
15. Samekh — ■ — Support, prop, encircling structure, upholding strength.
16. Ayin — ■ — Eye, sight, perception, spring, being seen or humbled.
17. Pe — ■ — Mouth, opening, speech, expression, fruit.
18. Tsade — ■ — Trail, pursuit, righteousness, hunting, provision.
19. Qof — ■ — Back of head, horizon, beyond, holiness, extremity.
20. Resh — ■ — Head, leader, beginning, priority, breath that leads.
21. Shin — ■ — Tooth, fire, consuming power, transformation, repetition.
22. Tav — ■ — Mark, sign, covenant seal, completion, truth.
